



Regular Day. This bell schedule is used on all regularly scheduled days of the academic school year.

PD Monday. Professional development (PD) is scheduled for staff on Mondays during the school year.

Early Dismissal. Days such as pep rally days and days before certain breaks are marked as early dismissal days on the calendar and will follow this bell schedule.

In-Service Half Day. This bell schedule is used on days that are marked as in-service half days. Typically, in-service half days are scheduled around parent teacher conferences.

Late Start Day. On rare occasions, late start days are scheduled during the school year. Late start days might also be scheduled due to unexpected weather incidents.

C-Day. On these days, additional time is built into third period to accommodate specific activities.

ETHS EMPLOYEE ABSENCE REPORTING (Certificated Staff)

To report a same day partial or full-day unplanned absence **before** 6:30am, you must log into AESOP at <https://www.aesoponline.com/login2.asp>. To report a same day partial or full-day unplanned absence **after** 6:30am, you must call the ETHS Staff Attendance Hotline at **847-492-3801**.

ETHS EMPLOYEE ABSENCE REPORTING (Non-Certificated Staff)

To report a same day partial or full-day unplanned absence, all non-teaching employees must notify their direct supervisor **AND** call the ETHS Staff Attendance Hotline at **847-492-3801**.

STUDENT ABSENCE REPORTING

(847) 424-7800

To report a partial day or full-day student absence, call the Student Attendance Line at (847) 424-7800. All full-day absences must be received by 10:00pm the following day. Phone calls regarding late arrivals and early dismissals must be received the same day prior to the student arriving late or leaving early. If a student will be arriving late or leaving early, see check in/check out procedures below. The absence reporting line is available twenty-four (24) hours a day to receive messages regarding attendance. The parent/guardian must state:

- The student's name and ID number
- The date(s) of the absence and period(s) to be missed
- Valid reason for the absence
- Parent/guardian name
- Their relationship to the student

To excuse a student in a language other than English, call the Latino Liaison/Minority Languages Office at 847-424-7166. *Para excusar a un estudiante en un idioma diferente del inglés, llamen a la Oficina del Enlace Latino/Idiomas Minoritarios al 847-424-7166.* ETHS will not accept notes unless a parent/guardian has shown the dean that there is no telephone in the household.

CHECKING IN/OUT OF SCHOOL

Checking In. Students arriving to school late will be marked tardy and assigned a consequence according to the tardiness procedures in *The Pilot*. If you arrive late, check in with a Safety Officer to receive an admit slip in order to enter your classroom. If you arrive late to school due to a pre-arranged medical appointment, your parent/guardian is required to call the Student Attendance Line at (847) 424-7800 *prior* to your arrival. You must report to the Attendance Office (S127) to check in once you arrive to school. The Attendance Office will issue you a Late Arrival Pass.

Checking Out. If you have a valid reason to check out of school before your last scheduled class is over, your parent/guardian is required to call the Student Attendance Line at (847) 424-7800 *prior* to your departure. If your leaving time occurs during a class period you must obtain your Leave Early Absence Pass from the Attendance Office (S127) prior to entering that class, i.e. before school starts or during an unscheduled period. **If a student leaves the building without following proper check-out procedures, the absence will be unexcused.** If a student returns to school after checking out, they must check back in at the Attendance Office. Failure to check back in properly will result in the student being marked absent for the remainder of the day. ETHS does not call students out of class regarding appointments.

VISITORS

All visitors must enter through either Entrance #1 (Dodge Avenue), or Entrance #2 (Wildkit Drive) and obtain a visitor pass from the Safety Office/Kiosk upon entering the building. A valid, government-issued photo ID is required. All visitors will be escorted to and from their intended destinations while visiting ETHS. Visitor passes must be clearly displayed and worn at all times.

Whenever possible, visitors should schedule an appointment in advance with the person(s) they wish to see. Convicted child sex offenders are not permitted on the campus unless certain conditions exist and they have received prior approval from school officials.

Exceptions to Visitor Requirements. Parents/guardians or community members who have been invited to visit ETHS as part of a scheduled open house, special event, scheduled performance by a class, team or group, or other adult participants in organized and school approved activities during off-school hours, are exempt from requirements. (See "Visitors" section in *The Pilot*.)



SCHOOL-TO-HOME COMMUNICATION

Evanston Township High School uses an automated notification system to inform ETHS families and staff of schoolwide events, school closings due to inclement weather or power outages, and crisis situations. The automated notification system will send messages to parents/guardians and students based on the contact information listed in the Home Access Center (HAC). ETHS staff will receive messages based on contact information provided in their Employee Access Center (EAC) account. **Parents and staff are encouraged to review their contact information before school begins, and should update information in these online systems as soon as information changes. Students will be contacted at their ETHS school email.**

STUDENT/PARENT PORTALS (www.eths.k12.il.us/onlinetools)

The ETHS website has two online portals for students and parents to monitor student learning, attendance, and accounts. A single user account provides access to both portals. User information for parent/guardian accounts is sent at the beginning of the school year. Parents requiring assistance can call 847-424-7121 or email homeaccesscenter@eths.k12.il.us. Freshman students receive their account information along with their Chromebooks at Freshman Orientation. Transfer students in grades 10-12 can stop by the South Technology Center (STC) for their account information. Students who need assistance with Home Access Center can stop by the STC.

Home Access Center (HAC) Portal & Mobile App. Students/parents/guardians can log in regularly to view assignments, attendance, grades, and class schedules online in Home Access Center. Parent users can update their phone and email contact information or request updates to registration information, and all users can view progress reports and report cards in HAC or sign up to receive these by email.

A mobile version of Home Access Center is available to view limited information such as attendance, schedules, classwork, report card, and notifications. Download the free app by searching for “eSchoolPlus+ Family” in the App Store or Google Play Store. Once you’ve loaded the app and selected “Evanston Twp. H.S. District 202”, use your regular HAC user name and password to log in. Parents/guardians may need to select a student.

myETHS. Students/parents/guardians can log in to their myETHS account to check community service records, detention balances, discipline reports, Drivers Education, ETHS Scholarships and prom registration (seniors only), PE locker information, progress toward honors credit, property tracking for electronic devices and bike registration, AM Support attendance, student accounts records, student polling (for student government and honorary offices), AP exam information and test accommodations (if applicable). Use your Home Access Center (HAC) user name and password your myETHS account. Students who need assistance with myETHS can stop by the STC.

SCHOOL CLOSING NOTIFICATION

If a delayed start, early dismissal, activity cancellation, or school closure is necessary, ETHS will issue a schoolwide email and voice message alert from the automated notification system and will post a notice on the ETHS website (www.eths.k12.il.us) and social media pages. School closings including unplanned late start days and early dismissals are reported on radio station WBBM-AM (780), on morning television programs, and online at www.emergencyclosings.com. Unless an alert is issued, ETHS will be open and operate on a normal school day schedule. If ETHS has a late start day or dismisses early due to inclement weather or other emergencies, before-school and after-school functions may be canceled. Isolated activity cancellations will be handled more personally on a smaller scale as required by the situation.

If school is in session on days when severe weather is predicted, students and staff are urged to allow extra time in the morning to get to school safely. Whether walking to school, taking the bus, driving, or being dropped off at school in a vehicle, students and staff are encouraged to take extra precautions to stay warm by wearing additional layers and protective outerwear. Parents are encouraged to make decisions about their child’s attendance at school based on current weather conditions and safe transportation to and from school. All ETHS employees are expected to make a reasonable effort to report to work as scheduled.

How to Report Claims of Bullying & Harassment at ETHS

If a student has experienced discrimination, bullying, harassment, sexual harassment, dating violence, or any other prohibited conduct, they should report their claim to their Dean. A student may choose to report their claim to a person of the same gender identity. Students who make good faith complaints will not be disciplined.

If a student or parent is ever concerned about an issue or situation related to their experience at ETHS, we want to hear about that, too. Anyone can submit comments and suggestions, and report any concerns using the "Contact Us" tool on the ETHS Mobile app or ETHS website (www.eths.k12.il.us/contact). The submissions can be anonymous or with your name, email or phone number. If you report concerns on this tool anonymously, school officials may be able to conduct a limited investigation or provide some assistance if you share enough details.
